



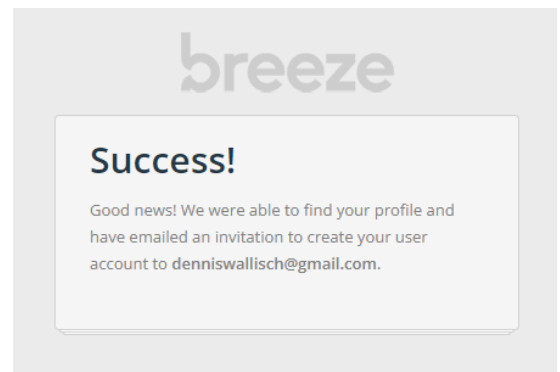

Step 1: Find account <https://lakenokomislutheranchurch.breezechms.com/login/create>

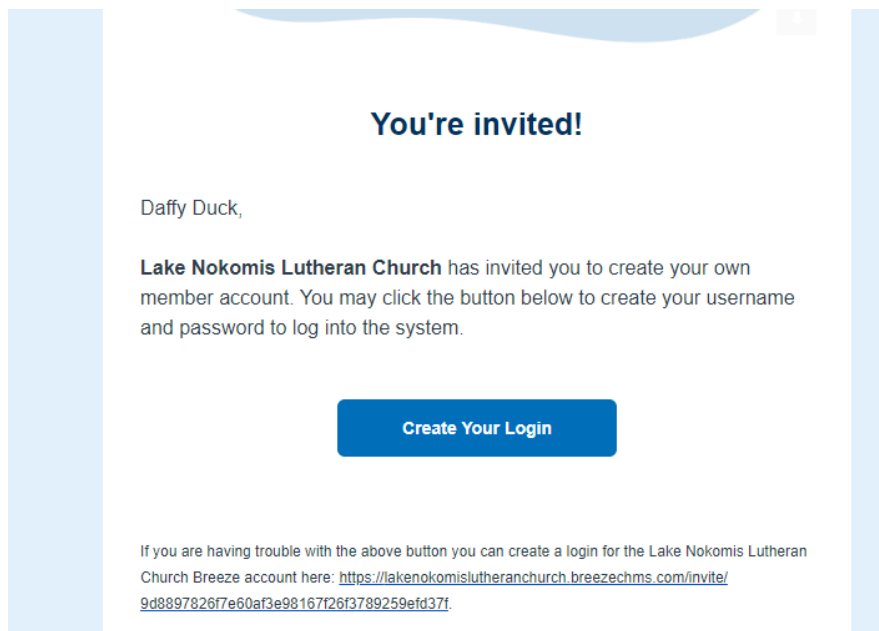

Step 2: Check your email and click on "create your login"




Step 3: Create your account

Click "Create User"




Step 4: You have created your account- Now you get to log in

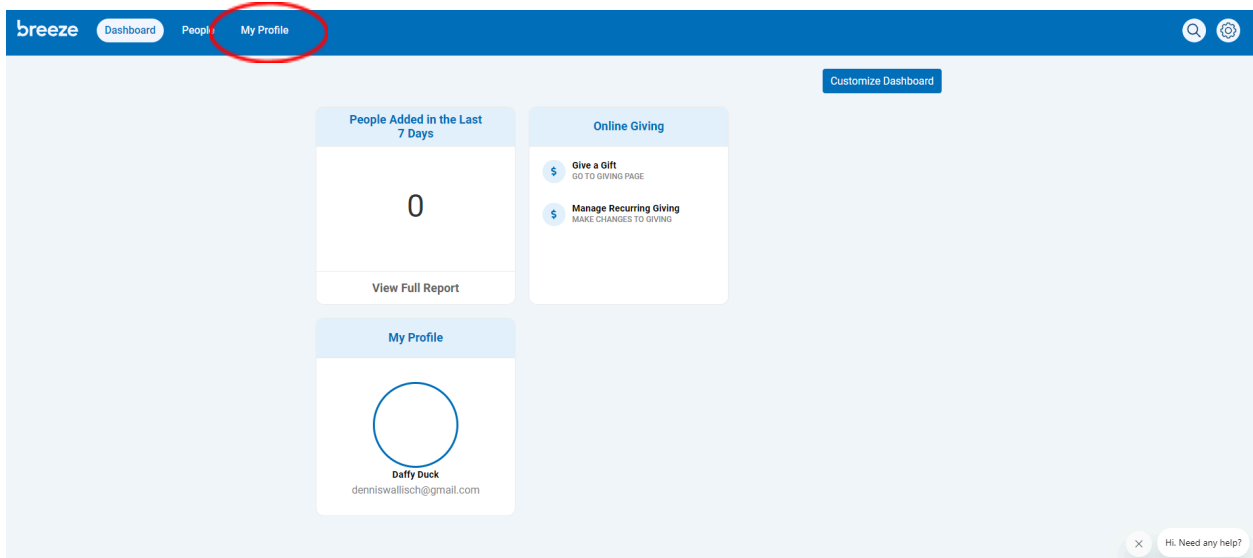

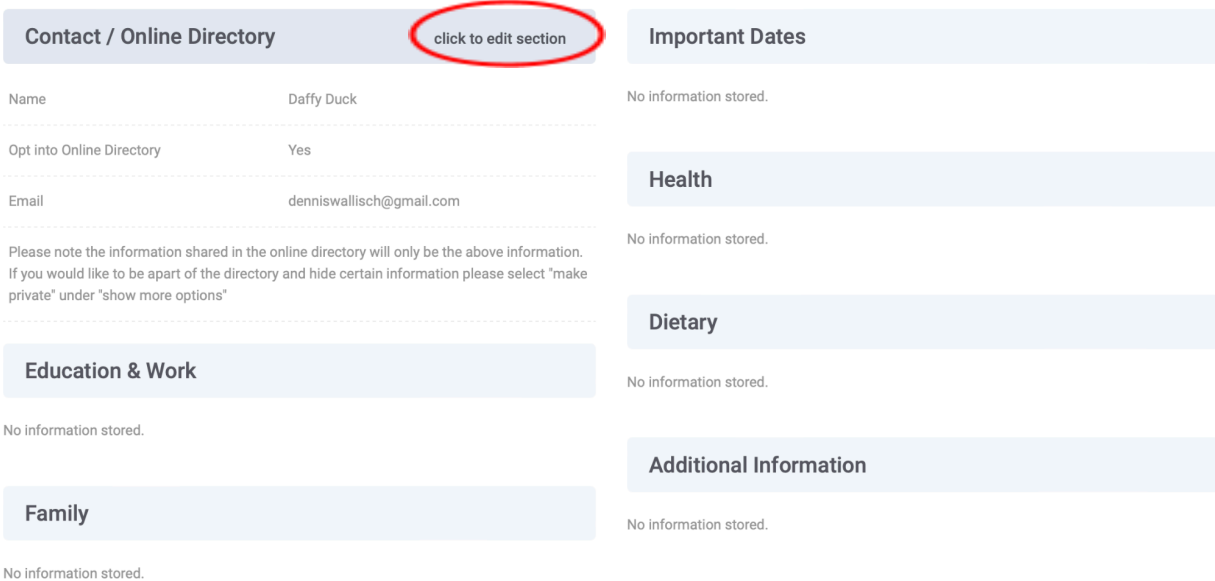
